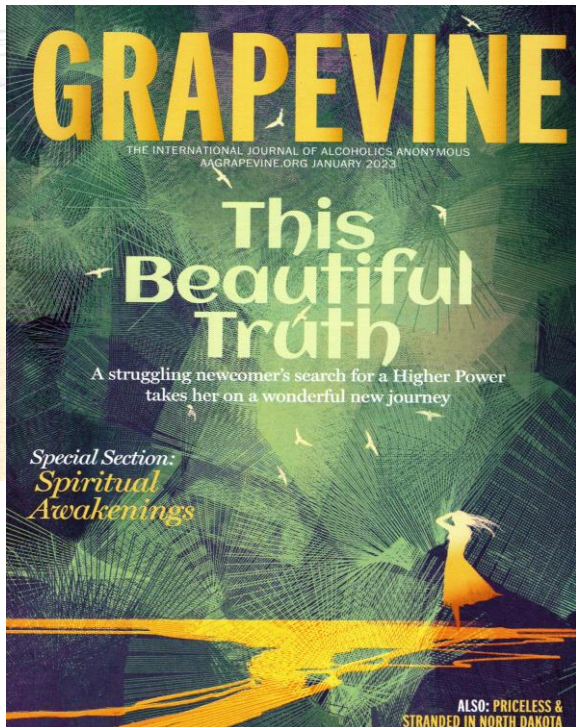

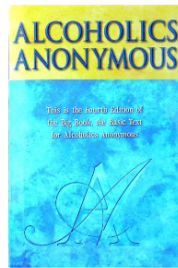
Standing Meetings
